7. REASONS FOR REJECTION

The following are the parameters of rejection of application of a candidate:

- (i) Non-receipt of any of the documentary proof in the form of self attested photocopies of qualification, mark-sheets, other certificate (s) etc.
- (ii) Non-receipt of caste certificate/ sub-category certificate, wherever applicable.
- (iii) Not possessing the degree/ desired qualification.
- (iv) Not fulfilling any of the laid down eligibility criteria.
- (v) Incomplete application or application not received on proper format within due date.
